Principal – Mr. Meengs:

Lots of focus on COVID from state and local health departments and sending almost daily COVID emails. Daily events typically affect sports so he and Mr. Noble work together. Having very productive conversations. There will be many of the senior events (honors convocation, prom, graduation, etc.) Some dates are still not finalized. Trying to manage time and location so we keep the events 10 days apart in the event of an outbreak at an event. For example, if an outbreak at honor's convocation, don't want kids missing graduation.

June 5 appears to still be the graduation date. Give Mr. Meengs a little more time finalize the calendar.

Mr. Meengs presented the ANP plan to Central Office. They were happy that we have a plan. We need to look at local ordinances for noise and lighting. Better that is on a Saturday night. Other concern is food at the event and having food on the field. Would like food trucks and beverages in parking lot as you lead up to the ticket booth. Have to have security in that area.

State mandated testing happening after Spring Break. All virtual the week after Spring Break but will have students in for testing. SAT on the 13th, Workkeys on the 14th, PSAT on 15th, PSAT-9 on the 16th. Mr. Meengs will send out the information and put in marauderinformant.com.
