## TOP 10 SCHOLARSHIPS FOR FEBRUARY 2017

### 1. **2017 Community Choice Foundation Scholarship**

**Deadline:** Feb. 1, 2017

**Award:** \$5,000

**Scholarship Overview:** Open to high school seniors in Michigan that will be graduating in the spring of 2017. Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 and be planning to attend a college or university in Michigan.

**Award:** Up to \$5,000

Applicant must have at least a 3.7 GPA. There is no citizenship requirement, but student must plan on attending a college in the U.S.

**Award:** Up to \$50,000

Program is looking for students whose projects are at, or close to, the college graduate level with a depth of knowledge in their particular area of study.

6. **Boren Scholarship**

**Deadline:** Feb. 9, 2017

**Award:** Up to \$20,000

**Scholarship Overview:** Open to U.S. undergraduate students to study less commonly taught languages in world regions critical to U.S. interests, and underrepresented in study abroad, including Africa, Asian, Central and Eastern Europe, Eurasia, Latin America, and the Middle East.

7. **Zeta Nu Zeta Z-Hope Scholarship**

**Deadline:** Feb. 13, 2017

**Award:** Varies
